

SEC. 3. The executive council shall, as provided by sections 1318 and 1319 of the Code, first assess the value of the property of the corporation using sleeping and dining cars not owned by such corporation, and shall then add to such valuation, the amount of the assessed valuation of said sleeping and dining cars, made as hereinbefore provided, and such aggregate amount shall constitute and be considered the assessed value of the property of such corporation for the purposes of taxation. Manner of assessment.

CHAPTER 115.

STATE UNIVERSITY.

AN ACT to prevent the use of the Funds of the State University for S. F. 311. Support of the Preparatory Department after July 1, 1879.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That after the 1st day of July, 1879, no part of the funds belonging to or appropriated for the state university shall be used for the support of the preparatory or non-collegiate course of studies heretofore taught in said university. Funds shall not be used for preparatory department.

CHAPTER 116.

TREASURER OF STATE.

AN ACT to amend Section 80, of Chapter 4, Title 2, of the Code of 1873. S. F. 303.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That section 80, of chapter 4, title 2, of the Code, be amended as follows: By striking out in the fourth line of said section the words, "March, June and September," and inserting "January, April and July;" also, strike out the word "November," in the fifth line, and insert "on the first day of October." Code, § 80, amended. In what months he shall report warrants taken up.
