## CHAPTER 135.

## F. D. LINDSLEY, J. P.

AN ACT to Legalize the Official Acts of F. D. Lindsley, a Justice of the H. F. 252. Peace in and for Benton county.

Whereas, In January, 1875, F. D. Lindsley was duly appointed Preamble. by the trustees of the township of Cedar to the office of justice of the peace in and for the county of Benton, and that the said F. D. Lindsley duly qualified as such justice of the peace as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, The electors of said township of Cedar, in said county of Benton, at the general election in 1875, failed and neglected to elect the said F. D. Lindsley, or any other person to

said office of justice of the peace; and,
WHEREAS, The said F. D. Lindsley continued to perform and
exercise the official duties of justice of the peace, in and for said county of Benton, from and after said general election in 1875, until his successor was elected and qualified in January, 1877, without being appointed anew by the trustees of said township of Cedar, or qualifying anew, by giving bond or otherwise after the general election in 1875; and,

WHEREAS, Doubts have arisen as to the legality of the official acts of the said F. D. Lindsley, as justice of the peace in and for said county of Benton, from and after the general election in 1875, until his successor was elected and qualified in 1877; there-

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That the official acts of F. D. Lindsley, as justice official acts of the peace in and for the county of Benton, from and after the legalized. general election in 1875, until his successor was elected and qualified in January, 1877, be and the same are hereby legalized and declared valid in all respects, the same as though the said F. D. Lindsley had been duly elected at the general election in 1875, or had been duly appointed and qualified as provided by law.
