CHAPTER 137.

PENITENTIARY OF THE STATE AT FORT MADISON.

AN ACT making Appropriations for the Improvement of the Peniten- H. F. 458. tiary of the State at Fort Madison.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of \$17,850 approany money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, or so printed. much thereof as may be necessary, for the several objects hereinafter named, to-wit:

For the purpose of repairing the roof of the cell-house, the sum

of one thousand five hundred dollars.

For the purpose of transportation of discharged convicts, the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars.

For the purpose of current repairs, the sum of two thousand dollars.

For the purpose of constructing a sewer to the river, the sum of eighteen hundred dollars.

For the purpose of constructing a work-shop, dining-room and chapel, the sum of ten thousand seven hundred dollars.

For purchasing a team, harness and wagon for the use of the

prison, three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350).

SEC. 2. The moneys hereby appropriated for the improvement How expendof said penitentiary shall be expended under the direction of the ed. warden, and in accordance with plans's ubmitted to and approved by the executive council.
