(\$1,500.00); for fitting up laboratory, fifteen hundred dollars, (\$1,-500.00); for re-construction of rear center, and mangles, ten thousand dollars, (\$10,000.00).

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the trustees of said hospital, at such times as may be deemed necessary by said trustees:

Provided, That any money remaining unexpended after the completion of the improvement for which the same is herein appropriated may be used as far as necessary for any of the pur-

poses specified in this act.

AN ACT Providing for the Employment of One Guard for every Eight H. F. 577. Prisoners at the Anamosa Penitentiary.
