thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any \$5,000 approfunds in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to meet transportation of an act known as the Military Code of Iowa, the requirements of an act known as the Military Code of Iowa, which are not otherwise provided for, and for payment of transportation of arms, ammunition and ordnance stores from the state arsenal to the various regimental and company headquarters of the Iowa national guard, and for the purchase of a seal for the adjutant-general's office.

SEC. 2. Said moneys shall be paid out only on vouchers duly Drawn on certified by the adjutant general, and approved by the governor,

showing the necessity of such expenditure.

Two thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, may be drawn during the year 1878, and the balance, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be drawn during the year 1879.

CHAPTER 186.

FURNISHING SUPPLIES FOR THE PENITENTIARIES.

AN ACT Amendatory to Section 4773, of Chapter 2, Title XXVI, of the S. F. 285. Code, Relating to the Furnishing of Supplies for the Penitentiaries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1.
