LAWS OF IOWA.

[Chap. 1.]

AN ACT to authorize Vinson H. Wamsley and Barnet Ristine to erect a dam across the Cedar fork of Skunk river, in the county of Henry, Iowa territory.

SECTION I. Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Iowa, That Vinson To erect dam. H. Wamsley and Barnet Ristine are hereby authorized to erect a dam across the Cedar fork of Skunk river, in the county of Henry, in said territory, on the northwest quarter of section twenty-one, township seventy-one north, range seven west, which dam shall not exceed six feet and a half high above low water mark: Provided the same shall not injure the mill of Lewis Watson on said stream.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall destroy or in any Injury to dam wise injure said dam, shall be deemed to have committed a trespass, and shall be liable accordingly, and any person who shall wilfully or maliciously destroy misdemeanor. or injure said dam, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined treble Treble damthe amount of damages the owner may have sustained, ages. or be imprisoned, at the discretion of the court.

SEC. 3. Nothing herein contained shall authorize Not to flow the individuals named in this act, their heirs or lands. assigns, to enter upon and flow the lands of any person, without the consent of such person, and they shall remove all such nuisances as may be occasioned by the erection of said dam, which may endanger the health of the vicinity.

AN ACT in relation to the safe custody of persons arrested for crimes and misdemeanors.

SECTION I. Be it enacted by the Council and House Person arrestof Representatives of the Territory of Iowa, That any transferred person arrested on a charge of any crime or misde-to another county. meanor, committed in any county of this territory,
