

CHAPTER 60.

LEGALIZING—INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF MARSHALLTOWN.

AN ACT to Legalize the Action of R. Howe Taylor, President of the H. F. 472.
Board of Directors of the Independent School District of Marshalltown Iowa, in Deeding Certain School Property.

WHEREAS, R. Howe Taylor, president of the board of directors ^{Preamble.}
of the independent school district of Marshalltown Iowa, did on the 3d day of September 1880, convey by deed to George Hum-long the following described property of said school district: forty feet *of off* [off of] the south end of lots No. one (1) two (2) and three (3) in block No. nine (9) in the original town of Marshall; now particularly described as follows: all that parcel or tract of land bounded by the following line; beginning at the southeast corner of said lot No. one (1) running thence north forty (40) feet, thence west one hundred and eighty (180) feet, thence south forty (40) feet, thence east one hundred and eighty (180) feet to the place of beginning; and,

WHEREAS, The question of the transfer or sale of said property not having been submitted to the electors of said Independent School District as provided by law; therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That the action of R. Howe Taylor, president of the board of directors of said district in deeding the above described property, is hereby legalized to the same extent as if the question of the sale and transfer of said property had been regularly submitted to the electors of said independent district. ^{Legalizing clause.}

CHAPTER 61.

LEGALIZING—TOWN OF MODALE.

AN ACT to Legalize the Acts of the Town Council of the Town of H. F. 502.
Modale in Harrison County Iowa.

WHEREAS, Immediately after the incorporation of the town ^{Preamble.}
of Modale, in Harrison county Iowa, a special election was called and held for the election of officers including a board of trustees, which board of trustees so elected at said special election discharged all the duties of trustees, as provided by law,
