

## CHAPTER 97.

## INCORPORATION OF TOWN OF GARRISON LEGALIZED.

AN ACT to Legalize the Incorporation of the Town of Garrison in Benton County, Iowa, and the Acts of the Officers Thereof. S. F. 33a.

WHEREAS, Certain questions have arisen in relation to the legality of the incorporation of the town of Garrison in Benton county, Iowa, and the legality of the acts of its council and officers, arising out of the alleged fact that the petition for the incorporation of said town was not signed by a sufficient number of electors within the proposed limits of said town, and

WHEREAS, The council and officers of said town have made ordinances and performed the acts usual and properly authorized by law to be done by such officers of such corporations, therefore,

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That the incorporation of the said town of Garrison, be and the same hereby is declared to be legal and valid to all intents and purposes, and the official acts of said council and officers are declared to be legal and valid to the same extent and in the same manner as though the said petition for said incorporation had been signed by the full and requisite number of the electors within the proposed limits of said town.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in force and effect from and after the publication thereof in the Iowa State Register, a newspaper published at Des Moines, Iowa and the Vinton Eagle, a newspaper published at Vinton in Benton county Iowa, without expense to the state.
