CHAPTER 110.

COLLEGE FOR THE BLIND.

AN ACT Making Appropriations for the College for the Blind.

H. F. 460.

\$8,500 appropriated.

\$1,200 for roof.

\$2.000 for music.

\$2.000 for furnishing.

\$500 for apparatus. \$2.000 for contingent.

Publication.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the college for the blind out of any funds not otherwise appropriated the following sums for the following purposes; to-wit: E pairing roof, the sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200). For re-

For musical instruments the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3.000).

For bedsteads, bedding and furniture the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

For school apparatus the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500). For contingent expenses the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

This act being deemed of immediate importance SEC. 2. shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and Iowa State Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.

CHAPTER 111.

DEAF AND DUMB.

AN ACT Making Appropriations for the Institution for the Deaf and Dumb at Council Bluffs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated for the institution for the deaf and dumb, the following sums for the purposes herein mentioned, to-wit:

For water supply eight thousand dollars (\$8,000).
