CHAPTER 166.

APPROPRIATION FOR AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE.

AN ACT Making Appropriations for the Iowa Agricultural College, H. F. 181.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated to the Iowa \$22,100 approagricultural college out of any moneys in the treasury not other-priated. wise appropriated, the sums for the purposes herein named to-

First. For building to be occupied by the mechanical and \$7,500 for civil engineering departments with proper fixtures, seven thou-mechanical,

Second. For two buildings to be occupied by the school of \$10,000 for two Veterinary Science, for recitation museum and hospital purposes, with proper out-buildings, fixtures and enclosures. Also science to contain rooms to be occupied by the sanitary department of the college, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000,000)

Third. For gasometer and repairs of gas works or electric \$3,500 for gasometer.

lights, thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00.)

Fourth. For house and barn on north farm, fifteen hundred \$1,500 for house and barn. dollars (\$1,500.00.)

Fifth. For pump house and water supply eight hundred dol- \$800 for pump-house. lars (\$800.00.)

Sixth. For purchase of house occupied by Professor Budd, \$2,800 for and addition to same twenty-eight hundred dollars (\$2,800.00.) house.

Seventh. For building to contain fire proof vault and office \$3,000 for of treasurer, secretary and president, three thousand dollars building. (\$3,000.00.)
Eighth. For one house to be used as a professors' residence \$3,000 for

with proper out-buildings, three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00.)

SEC. 2. That any sum remaining after the specific object for Unexpended which it was appropriated shall have been completed, may be balances. used so far as necessary for any of the other items, subject however, to the discretion of the executive council; provided Proviso: one that not more than one half of this appropriation shall be drawn half in 1884. from the treasury during the year 1884.

SEC. 3. That the trustees shall at the close of each month, Monthly represent to the auditor of state, a certified exhibit of all amounts port of trustees. due for labor done or material furnished during said month; and the auditor shall thereupon deliver to the treasurer of the Duty of audicollege, a warrant upon the state treasurer for the amount and tor of state.

no warrant shall issue except upon such exhibit.

SEC. 4. That the board of trustees shall take vouchers in vouchers in duplicate of all moneys under this appropriation, one of which duplicate. shall be filed in the office of the auditor of state.
