CHAPTER 202.

APPROPRIATION FOR FARMERS' PROTECTIVE ASOCCIATION.

AN ACT to Appropriate Funds to Aid the Farmers' Protective Association of Iowa in Litigation Relating to Patents on Barbed Wire.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there be, and is hereby appropriated, out of \$5.000 approany funds, not otherwise appropriated the sum of five thousand prized to aid (\$5,000) dollars, or so much thereof, as may be needed, to aid actions for intringement of the Farmers' Protective Association of Iowa, in defending in patents. actions now pending, or which may hereafter be brought in the state of Iowa on account of alleged infringments of patents on barbed wire, and for the purpose of testing the validity of said patents.

SEC. 2. That whenever the executive committee of said as-How drawn. sociation shall certify in writing to the auditor of state, that they are in need of funds for the purposes herein set forth, and shall enter into good and sufficient bond for the faithful disbursement of and accounting for said funds, then the said auditor shall issue his warrant upon the state treasurer for the amount asked for, which amount shall not in the aggregate, exceed the amount hereby appropriated, and the state treasurer shall pay such warrant upon presentation.
