CHAPTER 50.

ESTABLISH UNIFORM GAUGE OF CREAM.

8. F. 150. AN ACT to Establish a Uniform Inch or Gauge of Cream.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Cream gauge: Section 1. That an inch or gauge of cream shall be two-standard quarts wine measure, 115½ cubic inches.

CHAPTER 51.

DEFINING POWERS AND DUTIES OF CLERKS OF CIRCUIT COURT.

8. F. 33. AN ACT further defining the powers and duties of Clerks of the Circuit Court.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Clerks of circuit courts may approve bonds. SECTION 1. The clerks of the circuit court in their respective counties may approve the bonds of guardians of minors, or of other persons subject to guardianship.

Shall examiné sureties on bonds biennially.

SEC. 2. Such clerks shall during the month of January 1887 and during the same month in each even numbered year thereafter examine as to the sufficiency of the sureties upon all executor's and guardian's bonds in force in his office and having been executed more than one year prior to such time, and if he finds the same sufficient he shall note upon such bond his examination and re approval. If he shall not find the same sufficient, or if the sureties shall not re qualify on being by him so required to do, he shall note his disapproval on such bond and notify the executor or guardian of such disapproval and place the matter upon the calendar of the court at the next term thereof for proper order.

Publication.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and Des Moines Leader newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
