

CHAPTER 110.

APPROPRIATION FOR STATE NORMAL SCHOOL.

AN ACT Making Appropriations for the State Normal School at S. F. 208. Cedar Falls.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury the following sums for the aid and support of the State Normal School at Cedar Falls:

For salaries, \$21,600.	Salaries, \$21,600.
For apparatus, \$100.	Apparatus, \$100.
For steam-heating, \$200.	Steam heat, \$200.
For repairs and fire escapes, \$1,000.	Repairs, etc., \$1,000.
For coal sheds, \$200.	Coal sheds, \$200.
For sewerage, \$150.	Sewerage, \$150.
For contingent fund, \$2,000.	Contingent, \$2,000.

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated for teachers' salaries shall be paid quarterly, the first quarterly payment to be made July 1st, 1886, and the balance of the appropriations shall be paid at such times and in such sums as the board of directors may deem necessary, provided that not more than one-half of the total amount so appropriated shall be drawn during the year 1886.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force on and after its publication in the Iowa State Register, a newspaper published at Des Moines, and the Cedar Falls Gazette, a newspaper published at Cedar Falls, Iowa.
