CHAPTER 154.

CONGRESSIONAL APPORTIONMENT.

S. F. 329. AN ACT to Reorganize the Congressional Districts of the State. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa: SECTION 1. That the congressional districts be organized and constituted as follows: First district shall consist of the counties of Washington, 1st district Louisa, Jefferson, Henry, Des Moines, Lee and Van Buren. Second district shall consist of the counties of Muscatine, 2d district. Scott, Clinton, Jackson, Johnson and Iowa. Third district shall consist of the counties of Dubuque, Del-3d district. aware, Buchanan, Black Hawk, Bremer, Butler, Franklin, Hardin and Wright. Fourth district shall consist of the counties of Clayton, 4th district. Allamakee, Fayette, Winneshiek, Howard, Chickasaw, Floyd, Mitchell, Worth and Cerro Gordo. Fifth district shall consist of the counties of Jones, Linn, 5th district. Benton, Tama, Marshall, Grundy and Cedar. Sixth district shall consist of the counties of Davis, Wapello, 6th district. Keokuk, Mahaska, Poweshiek, Monroe and Jasper. Seventh district shall consist of the counties of Story, Dallas, 7th district. Polk, Madison, Warren and Marion. Eighth district shall consist of the counties of Adams, Union, 8th district. Clarke, Lucas, Appanoose, Wayne, Decatur, Ringgold, Taylor, Page and Fremont. Ninth district shall consist of the counties of Harrison, 9th district. Shelby, Audubon, Guthrie, Pottawattamie, Cass, Adair, Mills and Montgomery. Tenth district shall consist of the counties of Crawford, Car-10th district. roll, Greene, Boone, Calhoun, Webster, Hamilton, Pocahontas, Humboldt, Palo Alto, Kossuth, Hancock, Emmet and Winne-

bago.

Eleventh district shall consist of the counties of Lyon, Osceola, Dickinson, Sioux, O'Brien, Clay, Plymouth, Cherokee, Buena Vista, Woodbury, Ida, Sac and Monona.
