### CHAPTER 109.

### TRAVELING EXPENSES SUP'T PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

AN ACT to Amend Title XII, Chapter 1, of the Code Providing for H. F. 300. the Traveling Expenses of the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. For the expense of traveling required by section \$250 per annum 1577, of the code of 1873 the Superintendent of Public Instructure and 1877 of tion shall receive two hundred and fifty (250) dollars per annum code. or so much thereof as may be necessary for which warrants shall be drawn on his order by the Auditor of State upon the presentation of a verified statement of expenses incurred for the same.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are

hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance Publication. shall take effect and be in force after its publication in the Des Moines Leader and Iowa State Register, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.

## CHAPTER 110.

#### GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT.

AN ACT to Make Appropriations for the Payment of State Officers H. F. 629. and Other Bills and State Expenses.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any appropriation money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated and of officers now amount sufficient to pay the salaries of the various officers whose fixed by law. salaries are now fixed by law, and payable from the State
