CHAPTER 113.

AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT, ETC, AT CLARINDA.

8. F. 410.

AN ACT To authorize the Trustees of the Hospital for the Insane at Clarinda to employ a Superintendent and subordidate force to carry on said Hospital and farm connected therewith. And to appropriate six thousand dollars to pay for the same.

SECTION 1. That the trustees of the hospital for the insane

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

at Clarinda, Iowa, be and are hereby authorized to employ a Superintendent and the necessary subordinate force necessary to carry on the work of fitting up and finishing the apartments for the patients of said asylum, and to carry on the necessary improvement and work on said farm and that the sum of six thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the State treasury for the purpose of paying for the services of said Superintendent and subordinate force or so much as may be necessary until such time as the same can be paid for out of funds as provided by law. The said trustees shall have power to draw and expend said funds herein appropriated in such manner as they may find necessary for the purposes expressed in this Act.
