

CHAPTER 127.

APPROPRIATIONS—PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS STATE FAIR
GROUNDS.

AN ACT making an Appropriation to the Iowa State Agricultural Society, for making Permanent Improvements on the State Fair Grounds. S. F. 437.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Nine Thousand Five Hundred dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is appropriated hereby, out of any money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated to the Iowa State Agricultural Society for the purpose of making permanent and necessary improvements upon the State Fair Grounds. \$9500 appropriated.

Provided that not more than Five Thousand dollars of said sum be drawn from the Treasury on or before Dec 25th 1888, and Four Thousand Five Hundred dollars of said sum, the remainder thereof, on or after May 1, 1889. \$5000 may be drawn 1888. \$4500 in 1889.

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer upon Warrants of the Auditor of State, which shall be issued upon the requisition of the Iowa State Agricultural Society signed by the President and Secretary of said society. How paid.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader—newspapers published at Des Moines Iowa. Publication.

CHAPTER 128.

APPROPRIATIONS—COLLEGE FOR THE BLIND.

AN ACT making Appropriations for the College for the Blind at Vinton. H. F. 53.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the college for the blind at Vinton out of any money in the State Treasury Appropriation.
