CHAPTER 127.

APPROPRIATION: —PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS STATE FAIR GROUNDS.

AN ACT making an Appropriation to the Iowa State Agricultural S. F. 427. Society, for making Permanent Improvements on the State Fair Grounds.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Nine Thousand Five Hundred ***SOO appropride dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is appropriated hereby, out of any money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated to the Iowa State Agricultural Society for the purpose of making permanent and necessary improvements upon the State Fair Grounds.

Provided that not more than Five Thousand dollars of said \$5000 may be sum be drawn from the Treasury on or before Dec 25" 1888, and drawn 1888. Four Thousand Five Hundred dollars of said sum, the remain- \$4500 in 1889.

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be paid by How paid the State Treasurer upon Warrants of the Auditor of State, which shall be issued upon the requisition of the Iowa State Agricultural Society signed by the President and Secretary of said society.

APPROPRIATIONS-COLLEGE FOR THE BLIND.

AN ACT making Appropriations for the College for the Blind at H. F. 53.
Vinton.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the college Appropriation. for the blind at Vinton out of any money in the State Treasury
