## CHAPTER 188.

## APPROPRIATIONS-STATE LIBRARY.

H. F. 528.

## AN ACT Making Appropriations for the State Library.

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the State Appropriation. Library out of any money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated the following sums for the following purposes, towit:

Item first. For matting for the first floor and

Item third. For Book elevators,	100
Item fourth. For five additional tables for the

Total, \$ 1,700 SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the trustees of said Library, at such times

as they may deem necessary. SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and Des Moines Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
