CHAPTER 67.

HOSPITAL FOR INSANE INDEPENDENCE

AN ACT making appropriations for the Hospital for the Insane at H. F. 22. Independence.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

For Conservatory, two thousand dollars, (2,000)	
For sidewalk and improvement of ground two thous-	
and dollars, (2,000)	
For tile five hundred dollars, (500)	
SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn Manner of	t
nevment	

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn manner of and paid on the order of the Trustees of said Hospital in such sums and at such times as may de deemed necessary by said trustees; provided, that not more than one half of the amount herein appropriated shall be drawn from the treasury during the year 1890, and the balance in two equal installments the first on or after May 15th 1891, and the second on or after October 15th, 1891.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance Publication. shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register, and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
