# CHAPTER 70.

#### PENITENTIARY AT FORT MADISON.

## H. F. 410.

#### AN ACT making appropriations for the penitentiary at Fort Madison. Iowa.

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Imoa:

89,700 appropriated. SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the Penitentiary at Fort Madison, Iowa out of any funds in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated nine thousand and seven hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, in the following sums and for the following purposes, to-wit:

1.	For Transportation of Convicts,	52,000.
2.	For Contingent and Repair Fund,	7,500.
	For Furniture and Carpets,	

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the Warden of said Penitentiary at such times and in such sums as he may deem necessary; provided, that not more than one half shall be drawn in 1890, and the balance in two equal installments, the first on or after May 15th 1891, and the second on or after October 15th 1891.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
