It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a Bridges must steam engine over any bridge or culvert on any public highway in this state, without using four sound, strong planks, each to be not less than twelve feet long, one foot wide, and two inches thick; two of said planks to be kept continuously under the wheels of said engine while crossing said bridge or culvert.

It shall be unlawful for any person to blow the Whistle.

whistle of said engine on the public highway.

Any owner of a steam engine who by himself, agent or employe shall violate any of the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall for each offense be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars, to be recovered before any Recovered becourt of competent jurisdiction, and shall also be liable for of jurisdiction. all damages that may be sustained by persons or property by reason of his failing to comply with the provisions of this act. CHAPTER 69.

RELIEF OF UNION SOLDIERS, SAILORS AND MARINES.
