## CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to enable boards of school directors to provide free text-S. F. 40. books for pupils in the public schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa

SECTION 1. Whenever a petition signed by one-third Petition by or more of the legal voters, to be determined by the school legal voters. board of any school township or independent district, shall be filed with the secretary, thirty days or more before the Free textannual meeting of the electors, asking that the question book proposiof providing free text books, for the use of pupils in the public schools thereof, be submitted to the voters at the Notice to next annual meeting, he shall cause notice of such proposi-meeting. tion to be given in the call for such meeting.

If at such meeting a majority of the legal Directors may voters present and voting by ballot thereon shall authorize books by the board of directors of said school township or inde-direction of a pendent district to loan text-books to the pupils free of legal voters. charge, then the board shall procure such books, as shall be needed, in the manner provided by law for the purchase

of text books, and loan them to the pupils.

Sec. 3. The board shall hold pupils responsible for Pupils held any damage to, loss of, or failure to return any such books, responsible for loss or and shall adopt such rules and regulations as may be damage. reasonable and necessary for the keeping and preservation thereof.

## CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT to authorize kindergartens in independent school districts. H. F. 79. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:
