CHAPTER 95.

H. F. 237. AN ACT to punish the keeping and maintaining of resorts for the sale and use of opium and its preparations, and person or persons resorting thereto.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Sale and use of opium pro-

Section 1. That any person who shall keep and maintain in any shop, house, room, or other place, to be resorted to by other persons in which opium or any of its preparations or compounds is sold, or given away to be smoked or used in such place, or who allows opium or any of its preparations to be smoked in such house, shop, room, or other place, and every person who resorts to any such house, shop, room, or other place for the purpose of smoking opium or its preparations and compounds shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred doilars, or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding six months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Fine or imprisonment.

State may introduce evidence.

SEC. 2. The state upon the trial of any person indicted for keeping a place described in section one of this act may, for the purpose of establishing the character of the place so kept by the defendants, introduce evidence of the general reputation of such place as so kept, and such evidence shall be competent for such purpose.

Publication clause.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and Des Moines Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.

CHAPTER 96.

S. F. 7.

AN ACT to prohibit the manufacture and sale of cigarettes, cigarette paper, and cigarette wrappers, and providing penalites for the violation of the provisions thereof.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Manufacture and sale prohibited. SECTION 1. No one, by himself, clerk, servant, employe, or agent, shall, for himself or any person else, directly or indirectly, or upon any pretense, or by any device, manufacture, sell, exchange, barter, dispense, give in the consideration of the purchase of any property, or of any services, or in evasion of the statute, or keep for sale any cigarettes, or cigarette paper, or cigarette wrappers, or any paper made or prepared for the purpose of
