

CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT appropriating funds for the support of the State Fish Commission. s. F. 394.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of maintaining the state fish commission for the ensuing biennial period there is hereby appropriated the sum of six thousand dollars out of any funds not otherwise appropriated; Provided, that said fund be under the control of and audited by the executive council.

\$6,000 appropriated.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.

CHAPTER 149.

AN ACT to provide for an exhibit of the resources of the State of Iowa at the Trans-Mississippi and International Exposition to be held at Omaha in the year 1898. H. F. 482.

WHEREAS, Congress has passed a bill authorizing and encouraging the holding of the Trans-Mississippi and International Exposition at the city of Omaha in the state of Nebraska in the year 1898; and,

WHEREAS, It is very desirable that the agricultural, mineral, mechanical, industrial, and educational, and every resource and advantage of the state of Iowa shall be credibly represented in such exposition; therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That the executive council be and is hereby authorized and directed to appoint an exhibit commission to be known as the Iowa Trans-Mississippi and International Exposition committee. Such commission shall consist of eleven members, to be selected one from each congressional district in the state, not more than six of whom shall be from the same political party, and shall have full power to devise and execute plans for the said exhibit herein contemplated, and take charge of the same and dispose of the appropriations. It may appoint such officers as it in its judgment may deem necessary for the carrying out of the purposes of this act, including the right to delegate to the exhibit committee the duty and

Council to appoint commission.
