CHAPTER 122.

INTOXICATING LIQUORS.

S. F. 426.

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in section twenty-four hundred sixty-one-a (2461-a), supplement to the code, 1913, and extending the term "bootlegger" to include those who solicit, take, or accept orders for the sale, shipment, or delivery of intoxicating liquors contrary to law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. "Bootlegger" defined. That the law as it appears in section twenty-four hundred sixty-one-a (2461-a), supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by inserting in the fifth (5th) line thereof, after the comma (,) following the word "otherwise", the following:

6 'or who shall within this state, in any manner, directly or in-7 directly, solicit, take, or accept any order for the sale, shipment, or 8 delivery of intoxicating liquor,"

CHAPTER 123.

INTOXICATING LIQUORS.

S. F. 423,

AN ACT to amend section twenty-four hundred five (2405) of the code, relating to actions to abate and enjoin liquor nuisances.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Action to abate—decree—scope. That section twenty-four hundred five (2405) of the code be and the same is hereby amended by striking from the thirteenth and fourteenth lines thereof the following:

"judicial district in which it was issued" and substituting in lieu thereof the word "state". Also by striking from said section 2405 of the code, the words "in said district" and by substituting in lieu thereof the words "within the state".
