CHAPTER 167.

BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS.

S. F. 393.

AN ACT to amend section two thousand four hundred seventy (2470) of the supplement to the code, 1913, and to amend section two thousand four hundred seventy-three (2473) of the code relating to the duties of the commissioner of the bureau of labor statistics, and relating to the meaning or definitions of the terms "factory", "mill", and other like terms.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Bulletins authorized. That section two thousand four hundred seventy (2470) of the supplement to the code, 1913, is hereby amended by adding to said section immediately after the last word thereof, the following, to wit: "Said commissioner may from time to time, with the consent of the executive council, issue bulletins containing information of importance to the industries of the state and to the safety of wage earners."
- SEC. 2. Meaning of terms. That section two thousand four hundred seventy-three (2473) of the code is hereby amended by striking from lines four (4) and five (5) thereof, the following words, to wit: 4 "five or more".

CHAPTER 168.

SAFETY APPLIANCES.

S. F. 392.

AN ACT to amend section four thousand nine hundred ninety-nine-a-five (4999-a5), supplement to the code, 1913, relating to the removal of safety appliances on machinery.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Removal of safety appliances. That section four 2 thousand nine hundred ninety-nine-a-five (4999-a5), supplement to
- 3 the code, 1913, is hereby amended by inserting in the sixteenth line of
- 4 said section and immediately following the comma (,) at the end of said line, the following words, to wit: "or safeguarding health".
