## CHAPTER 265.

CENSUS OF RESOURCES OF STATE IN MEN AND MATERIALS AVAILABLE IN EVENT OF WAR.

S. F. 567.

AN ACT providing for a census and inventory of the resources of the state.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Census—resources available in event of war. The governor is hereby authorized to cause to be taken forthwith, a census and inventory of the resources of this state in men and material available for use in the event of war, and the information thereby secured shall be placed at the service of both the state and federal governments.
- SEC. 2. Duty of citizens. In the preparation of such census and inventory it shall be the duty of every public official and citizen in the state to furnish to the governor whatever information or assistance he may require.
- SEC. 3. Advisory board. The governor is hereby authorized to appoint, to assist in the work of taking the census and inventory, an advisory board to serve without pay.
- SEC. 4. Expenses. For the purpose of the preparation of the census and inventory of the resources of the state, the expenses incurred under this act shall be paid out of any funds in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants drawn by the auditor and audited by the audit board.
- SEC. 5. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the preparation of the census and inventory of the resources of this state in men and material available for use in the event of war.
- SEC. 6. Publication clause. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall be in force and effect from and after its publication in the Des Moines Capital and Des Moines Register, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
