SEC. 2. Supervision—requirements. The construction of said improvement shall be under the control and supervision of the board of control, and the material shall be brick, concrete, asphalt or other hard material approved by the state engineer, and equal in all respects to the pavement of the streets of Knoxville, with which the same shall connect, but said improvement shall not be begun until the city of Knoxville shall have completed the paving of said street or highway from the east end of that herein provided for and connecting the same with the paved streets of the city of Knoxville.

SEC. 3. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated for the payment of the cost of said improvement the sum of eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay for said improvement, to be paid out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

CHAPTER 288.

APPROPRIATION FOR UNCOMPLETED BUILDINGS FOR STATE INSTITUTIONS.

H. F. 260.

AN ACT making appropriations for the construction of buildings, for the State University of Iowa, and the Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing for the completion of buildings now authorized or under construction by the Iowa state board of education, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) to be available July 1, 1917, for the following purposes:
State University of Iowa, fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).

Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts, fifty thousand

9 dollars (\$50,000.00).

10 The appropriations provided for in this section shall be paid on 11 the order of the Iowa state board of education.
