- SEC. 3. Annual reports. Any corporation, organized as provided in section one (1) hereof, shall, between the first day of July and the first day of August of each year, make an annual report to the secretary of state, said report to be in such form as he may prescribe and upon a blank to be prepared by him for that purpose.
 - SEC. 4. Forfeiture. Should any corporation referred to in section one (1) hereof fail to comply with the provisions of this act, notice of such failure shall be called to its attention by the secretary of state by registered letter and, if such delinquent corporation fails or neglects to comply with this act within sixty (60) days from the receipt of such letter from the secretary of state, then and in such case said corporation shall forfeit its right to do business in this state.

CHAPTER 355.

CONSPIRACY TO SEIZE RAILROAD ENGINES OR CARS.

H. F. 381.

AN ACT relating to the unlawful boarding of engines and cars or with intent to commit a public offense, and providing a penalty therefor.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Conspiracy. If any two or more persons maliciously and wilfully confederate together for the purpose of going upon or taking charge of any locomotive engine or car of any railroad company by force and without the consent of the person or persons in charge thereof, or if one or more persons shall go upon any locomotive engine or car of any railroad company armed with a dangerous or deadly weapon for the purpose of committing a public offense thereon, he shall be imprisoned in the penitentiary for not exceeding five (5) years or pay a fine of not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1000).
