## CHAPTER 389.

## TRANSCRIPTS OF JUDGMENTS IN INFERIOR COURTS.

#### S. F. 529.

AN ACT to repeal section forty-five hundred thirty-seven (4537) of the code and to enact a substitute in lieu thereof, relating to the filing of transcripts from justice's or mayor's court with the clerk of the district court.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Inferior courts transcripts filing authorized. That section forty-five hundred thirty-seven (4537) of the code be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu
- thereof: "A party obtaining a judgment in the justice's or mayor's court may cause a transcript thereof to be certified to the office of
- the clerk of the district court in the county."
- Sec. 2. Mayor's courts—prior filings legalized. All transcripts from mayor's courts heretofore filed in the office of the clerk of the district court as provided in this section, shall from and after the taking effect of this act have the same force and effect as though from
- the office of the justice of the peace.

# CHAPTER 390.

### REGULATION OF CARRIERS.

S. F. 509.

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in section two thousand one hundred fifty (2150) of the code, relating to free transportation or reduced rates by carriers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Reduced rates on highway materials. That the law as it appears in section 2150 of the code, be and the same is hereby
- amended by inserting after the word "governments," and preceding the words "by common carriers," in the fourth line thereof, the fol-
- lowing: "or for materials to be used by public authorities in con-
- structing or maintaining public highways outside of the corporate limits of cities and towns.
