CHAPTER 28.

SOLDIERS, SAILORS, ETC.

H. F. 62.

AN ACT providing that certified copies of public records be furnished free of charge to any soldier, sailor or marine, in service or honorably discharged, or any dependent of such soldier, sailor or marine.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Free copies of records. That whenever a certified copy or copies of any public record in the state of Iowa are required to 3 perfect the claim of any soldier, sailor or marine, in service or honorably discharged, or any dependent of such soldier, sailor or marine, for a United States pension, or other claim upon the government of the United States, they shall, upon request, be furnished by the cus-7 todian of such records, without requiring any fee or compensation therefor.

CHAPTER 29.

DRAINAGE OF HIGHWAYS.

H. F. 70.

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in section nineteen hundred eighty-nine-b ten (1989-b10), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, referring to costs in case of abandonment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Costs in case of abandonment. That the law as it appears in section nineteen hundred eighty-nine-b ten (1989-b10), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, be, and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "road" in the fourth line thereof. 3
