CHAPTER 81.

STATE BOARD FOR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION.

H. F. 110.

AN ACT to amend section ten (10) of chapter two hundred ninety (290) of the acts of the thirty-seventh (37th) general assembly, and appropriating money for the expenditures of the state board for vocational education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Expenses—additional appropriation. That section ten
- (10) of chapter two hundred ninety (290), of the acts of the thirtyseventh (37th) general assembly be amended by adding thereto the 3
- 4 following:
- "There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the state treasury
- not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two thousand fifty dollars
- (\$2,050) in addition to any appropriation heretofore made, for the actual expenses of said board for vocational education for the period
- from March 1, 1919, to June 30, 1919." 9
