## CHAPTER 126.

## IOWA STATE FAIR GROUNDS.

S. F. 192.

AN ACT to provide for purchasing additional land for the Iowa state fair and for paying paving and curbing assessment against the Iowa state fair grounds and to make appropriations therefor.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. State fair grounds—additional land—paving and curbing-appropriation. There is hereby appropriated to the Iowa Department of Agriculture, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of sixty-three thousand dollars (\$63,000) for the following purposes:

For purchasing additional land for state fair ground purposes fifty-4

four thousand dollars (\$54,000). 6

For paying paving and curbing assessment against the Iowa State Fair Grounds nine thousand dollars (\$9,000). 8

- SEC. 2. Appropriation—how drawn. The amounts appropriated by 1 this act shall be drawn from the state treasury upon warrants issued by the state auditor upon the order of the state board of agriculture. 3 signed by the president and secretary. 4
- 1 SEC. 3. Publication clause. This act, being deemed of immediate 2 importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-
- cation in Des Moines Register and Des Moines Capital, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
