sand dollars of money in the general fund of the district was transferred to the school house fund thereof for the purpose of paying school house bonds of the district, and

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen as to the legality of such transfer and resolution and these doubts should be removed and the transfer validated; therefore

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Transfer legalized. That the transfer of ten thousand dollars of money from the general fund of such school district unto
- the school house fund 's made and provided by the resolution of said
- board of directors passed on March 1st, 1924, is hereby confirmed and
- declared to be legal and valid.
- 1 SEC. 2. Litigation. Nothing in this act shall affect pending litiga-2 tion.
- Publication. This act being deemed of immediate impor-1
- tance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publica-
- tion in the Des Moines Register, a newspaper published in Des Moines,
- Iowa, and in the Laurens Sun, a newspaper published in Laurens, Iowa,
- all without expense to the state.

## CHAPTER 71

## DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

S. F. 324

AN ACT to make an emergency appropriation for the department of agriculture.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Weather and crop service. There is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appro-
- priated, to the department of agriculture for use in the weather and
- crop service of such department, the sum of two hundred dollars
- (\$200.00). The emergency appropriation provided for in this section shall be available immediately upon taking effect of this act.
- 1 SEC. 2. Publication. This act, being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication
- in the Des Moines Register and the Des Moines Capital, newspapers
- published in Des Moines, Iowa.
