## CHAPTER 184

### BONDED WAREHOUSES

S. F. 7

AN ACT to amend section nine thousand seven hundred nineteen (9719) of chapter four hundred twenty-six (426) of the 1924 code, relating to bonded warehouses for agricultural products.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. **Definition of term.** That section nine thousand seven  
 2 hundred nineteen (9719) of the code, 1924, be and the same is hereby  
 3 amended by striking out lines nine (9) to twelve (12) inclusive and  
 4 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 "The term 'agricultural product' as used in this chapter shall mean  
 6 cotton, wool, grain, tobacco, flax seed, sugar and all canned goods made  
 7 from agricultural products."

1 SEC. 2. **Publication clause.** This act being deemed of immediate  
 2 importance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publica-  
 3 tion in the Des Moines Register, a newspaper published in the city of  
 4 Des Moines, Iowa, and the Des Moines Capital, a newspaper published  
 5 in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.
