CHAPTER 229

RELIEF OF D. E. BULLOCK

H. F. 398

AN ACT to provide an appropriation of twenty-five hundred dollars to indemnify D. E. Bullock for injuries received by the claimant while serving in the Iowa national guard at Camp Dodge, Iowa, October 13, 1919.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated out of
- any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum
- of twenty-five hundred dollars to indemnify D. E. Bullock for injuries
- received by the claimant while serving in the Iowa national guard at
- Camp Dodge, Iowa, October 13, 1919.
- Receipt. The receipt of said sum of money by the said 1
- D. E. Bullock shall be in full settlement and satisfaction of all claims
- for injuries resulting to the said D. E. Bullock.
- SEC. 3. Publication clause. This act being deemed of immediate
- importance shall become effective from and after its passage and
- publication in the following named newspapers, without expense to
- the state: The Des Moines Daily Record and Plain Talk, newspapers
- published at Des Moines, Iowa.

CHAPTER 230

PURCHASE OF LAND IN MILLS COUNTY

H. F. 230

AN ACT to appropriate fourteen thousand five hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$14,578.00) for the purpose of purchasing seventy-eight and eighty one-hundredths (78.80) acres of land in Mills county, Iowa.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Appropriation. That there is hereby appropriated out
- of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the
- sum of fourteen thousand five hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$14,-
- 578.00) for the purchase of seventy-eight and eighty one-hundredths
- (78.80) acres of land adjoining the state farm in Mills county, Iowa.
