CHAPTER 6

CODE EDITOR

S. F. 46

AN ACT to authorize the code editor to omit certain formal matters in the compilation of the code.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Formal matters omitted. When any act of the general assembly subsequent to the issuance of the code of 1924 contains in the substantive part of the act a reference to a section of the code and designates such section by such reference as "Code, 1924", "Code, 1927", "Code, 1931", etc., or the equivalent thereof, the code editor is directed in the preparation of the ensuing code to omit the year indicated by such reference.

CHAPTER 7

STATE PRINTING BOARD

H. F. 91

AN ACT to repeal sections 180 (one hundred eighty) and 214 (two hundred fourteen) of the code and to enact a substitute therefor, relating to the state printing board and to the superintendent of printing.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Sections 180 (one hundred eighty) and 214 (two hundred fourteen) of the code are repealed and the following is enacted in lieu thereof:
- "180. Financial interest. No member of said board and no appointee thereof shall be financially interested, directly or indirectly, in any plant or business in which work is performed for the state,
- 7 under the provisions of this and the two following chapters, nor shall 8 he be interested in any contract let under said chapters."
