to county bridge fund, if approved by a judge of the district court in the county seeking to make such transfer at a hearing had on a day to be fixed by said judge.

Not less than five days before the date of said hearing notice thereof 8 shall be given by publication in one or more newspapers published 9 within the county seeking to make the transfer. The notice shall be 10 addressed generally to the taxpayers and the public of the county proposing to make the transfer, and shall recite the substance of the 11 resolution adopted by the board of supervisors and set forth, specif-12 13 ically, the funds from and to which the transfer is to be made, the amount of money involved and the time when objections to the pro-14 15 posed transfer shall be filed. Proof of publication shall be made as 16 for the publication of original notices, and the order of the judge 17 approving or disapproving of the transfer, shall be indorsed on the original resolution and entered in the record book of the county 18 19 auditor as a part of said resolution, and a copy of said order shall be transmitted to the director of the budget. 20

CHAPTER 14

IOWA WAR FLAGS

S. F. 310

AN ACT to authorize the executive council to transfer funds and to use certain funds for preservation of Iowa war flags.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. The executive council is authorized and empowered to transfer ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) from unexpended balances in capital expenditure appropriations, as of June 30, 1927, to a fund to be expended for the preservation and display of the War of the Rebellion, the Spanish American, and World War flags of Iowa.
- SEC. 2. The executive council is directed to expend said ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the construction of suitable cabinets or cases in the capitol building for the purpose of preserving and displaying said flags.
