SCHOOLS AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS

AN ACT to repeal sections forty-three hundred twenty-two (4322), forty-three hundred twenty-three (4323), and forty-three hundred twenty-four (4324) of the code, 1924, and to enact substitutes therefor, relating to public school libraries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section forty-three hundred twenty-two (4322) of the code, 1924, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

The auditor of each county in this state shall withhold annually from the money received from the apportionment for the several school districts, fifteen cents for each person of school age residing in each school corporation, as shown by the annual report of the secretary, for the purchase of books, as hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2. Section forty-three hundred twenty-three (4323) of the code, 1924, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Between the first Monday of July and the first day of October in each year, the county board of education shall expend all money withheld by the auditor, as provided in the preceding section, in the purchase of books for the use of the school district, and shall distribute the books thus selected to the librarians among the several school districts in the proportion that the number of persons of school age living in the school district bears to the number of such persons living in the county.

1 SEC. 3. Section forty-three hundred twenty-four (4324) of the 2 code, 1924, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu 3 thereof:

The state board of educational examiners shall prepare annually lists of books suitable for use in school district libraries, and furnish copies of such lists to each county superintendent and to each member of each county board of education.
