CITIES AND TOWNS

AN ACT to amend sections fifty-six hundred thirty-two (5632) and fifty-six hundred thirty-three (5633) of the code, 1924, relating to the election and appointment of officers in cities and towns.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section fifty-six hundred thirty-two of the code, 1924, is hereby amended by striking out of lines three (3) and four (4), the following:

"the solicitor, auditor, and city engineer, and", so that the section

5 when amended shall read as follows:

"5632. Officers elected at large. In all cities and towns, the mayor, treasurer, and assessor, and in cities of the first class, where there is no municipal or superior court, the police judge, shall be elected by the entire electorate."

1 SEC. 2. Section fifty-six hundred thirty-three (5633) of the code, 2 1924, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "5633. Officers appointed by council. In all cities and towns, the 4 council at its first meeting after the biennial election shall appoint 5 a clerk and may appoint a city solicitor, a city engineer, and an 6 auditor."
