## CHAPTER 168

## CITIES AND TOWNS—TAXATION

## H. F. 206

AN ACT to repeal section sixty-five hundred seventy-eight (6578) of the code, 1924, and to enact a substitute therefor, relating to the levy of a tax for parks and cemeteries by cities under commission form of government.

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section sixty-five hundred seventy-eight (6578) of the code, 1924, is hereby repealed and the following enacted as a substitute therefor:
- 4 In addition to the taxes now or hereafter authorized by law, every such city shall have the power to levy annually upon all taxable 5 property therein a tax of not more than two and five-tenths mills on 6 the dollar for the purpose of caring for and improving the parks of 7
- said city, or any cemetery owned by such city, or both such parks and 8
- 9 cemetery.
- SEC. 2. In case of the improvement of roads and highways in such parks or cemetery, or in both, the collection of such tax or a part 3
- thereof may be anticipated for a period of not to exceed ten years, and the provisions of sections sixty-two hundred sixty-one (6261) to
- sixty-two hundred sixty-four (6264), inclusive, of the code shall apply
- so far as applicable.
