20 jected to a temperature of one hundred forty-five (145) degrees Fahrenheit, and held at that temperature not less than twenty-five 21 22 (25) minutes.

Milk, skimmed milk, and cream shall be deemed to have been efficiently pasteurized by the "flash heat process" when it has been subjected to a temperature of one hundred eighty-five (185) degrees Fahrenheit.

3076. a-2. Record of pasteurization. Every owner, manager or operator of a creamery or ice cream factory, shall equip each vat or pasteurizer used in pasteurizing cream with an accurate recording thermometer, and each temperature chart from such thermometer shall be dated and kept on file for inspection by the department, and it shall be unlawful to destroy any such chart without permission from the secretary of agriculture.

3076. a-3. Injunction. Any owner, manager, or operator of a creamery, or ice cream factory, violating any of the provisions of the three (3) preceding sections may be restrained by injunction from operating any such business. No injunction shall issue until after the defendant has had at least five (5) days notice of the application therefor and the time fixed for hearing thereon.

EDUCATION OF DEAF CHILDREN

AN ACT to amend chapter ninety-two (92), acts of the forty-first general assembly, relating to the education of deaf children.
