- 2. be in full satisfaction and settlement of any claim against the state 3 of Iowa growing out of the said injury.
- SEC. 3. The auditor of state is hereby authorized to draw a warrant to B. F. Skyles for the said sum and the treasurer of state is hereby authorized to pay same upon presentation.

CHAPTER 312

H. C. JONES

S. F. 445

AN ACT to make appropriation to H. C. Jones to compensate him for hospital and medical care of Patricia Jones.

WHEREAS, Patricia Jones of Ames, Iowa, was injured on the 3rd day of February, 1927, by being struck by an automobile driven by an employee of the Iowa state college; and

WHEREAS, H. C. Jones has paid the sum of one hundred ninety-five dollars (\$195.00) for medical care, attention, and nursing of the said Patricia Jones; and

WHEREAS, under statements of physicians made and filed herein it is not possible to determine the extent of permanent injuries resulting to the said Patricia Jones; and

WHEREAS, the said claim of the said Patricia Jones cannot at this time be fully determined or ascertained; therefore

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to H. C. Jones for care and medical attention rendered by him to Patricia Jones for injuries received when struck by an automobile driven by an employee of the Iowa state college the sum of one hundred ninety-five dollars (\$195.00).
- SEC. 2. The auditor of state is hereby authorized to draw a warrant for said sum to the said H. C. Jones and the treasurer of state is authorized to pay said warrant out of the funds appropriated to the Iowa state board of education.
- SEC. 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed to bar the said H. C. Jones or the said Patricia Jones from filing a claim with any succeeding general assembly for claims for further medical care or attention or for other damages resulting from any said injury to the said Patricia Jones.
