CHAPTER 39

BOARD OF CONSERVATION TO ESTABLISH BOUNDARIES

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in section eighteen hundred thirteen (1813) of the code, 1927, to permit the board of conservation to establish boundary lines between state owned and privately owned property only when said board deems the establishment thereof feasible and necessary.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. That the law as it appears in section eighteen hundred thirteen (1813) of the code, 1927, be and the same is hereby amended by adding after the word "property" in line four (4) thereof, the 3

- "when said board deems it feasible and necessary". 5
