- Iowa in participating therein and for the purpose of insuring that no portion of the appropriation herein provided shall be used under any other circumstances or conditions. It is provided that no action shall be taken under the provisions of this act and no money paid from the appropriation provided herein until the executive council shall by proper resolution entered of record direct and authorize the same.

CHAPTER 250

PURCHASE OF PROPERTY BY EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

AN ACT to authorize the executive council to purchase and improve certain property adjacent to the capitol extension grounds and to make an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. The executive council is hereby authorized to purchase the real estate adjoining the capitol extension on the east and described as lots one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5) and six (6) of block six (6), Allen, Polk and Hubbells replat of W. A. Scott's addition to the city of Des Moines, upon such terms as may be deemed beneficial to the state.
- SEC. 2. For the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of section one (1) hereof, there is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary.
- SEC. 3. There is hereby appropriated to the executive council from the general funds of the state not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to make such improvements on the premises described in section one (1) as said executive council may consider necessary, in case said property is purchased by the executive council as herein provided.
- SEC. 4. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the Correctionville News, a newspaper published at Correctionville, Iowa, and in the Pierson Progress, a newspaper published at Pierson, Iowa.
