- 6 shall be construed as limiting the right of a school board to make a 7 contract for a higher wage than herein specified as a minimum."
- SEC. 2. The county board of education may temporarily suspend the provisions hereof if, in its judgment, the financial conditions in
- 3 any district warrant such action.
- SEC. 3. Sections forty-three hundred forty-two (4342), forty-three hundred forty-three (4343), and forty-three hundred forty-four (4344), code, 1931, are hereby repealed.
- SEC. 4. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication in the Eldon
- 3 Forum, a newspaper published at Eldon, Iowa, and in the West Lib-
- 4 erty Index, a newspaper published at West Liberty, Iowa.

CHAPTER 66

SCHOOLS. USE OF PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS

H. F. 145

AN ACT to amend section forty-three hundred seventy-one (4371), code, 1931, relating to the use of public school buildings for other than school purposes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section forty-three hundred seventy-one (4371), code, 2 1931, is amended as follows:
- 1. Strike from lines three (3) and four (4) the words "and not within the limits of a city or town".
- 5 2. Insert immediately after the word "purposes" in line seven (7) 6 the following:
- 7 ", and for other meetings of public interest; provided that such 8 use shall in no way interfere with school activities".
