CHAPTER 219

MRS. LEE HARRIS, GUARDIAN

S. F. 490

AN ACT to make an appropriation to Mrs. Lee Harris, guardian of Burton Harris.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of the primary road fund, the sum of thirty-one hundred and ninety dollars (\$3,190.00), to be paid to Mrs. Lee Harris, as guardian of Burton Harris, in compensation for injuries received by the said Burton Harris during the month of July, 1931, when the automobile in which he was riding on a new road, which was being constructed for a relocation of road num-7 ber 61, near Wapello, Iowa, going into a drainage ditch which crossed said highway, where a bridge had not yet been constructed and there was no barrier or warning sign.
- 1 The auditor of state is hereby directed to issue his war-2 rant payable to the said Mrs. Lee Harris, as guardian of Burton Harris, 3 in said sum of thirty-one hundred and ninety dollars (\$3,190.00) and 4 the treasurer of state is hereby authorized and directed to pay said 5 warrant and to charge the same to the primary road fund of the state of Iowa. 6
- SEC. 3. Receipt of said sum of thirty-one hundred and ninety dollars (\$3,190.00) by the said Mrs. Lee Harris, as guardian of Burton Harris, shall be in full settlement of any and all claims by said minor, or his representatives, against the state of Iowa growing out of said incident and damages resulting therefrom.
