## CHAPTER 174

#### CITIES UNDER COMMISSION PLAN

### S. F. 34

AN ACT to amend section sixty-five hundred sixty-four (6564) of the Code, 1935, relating to general powers and duties of the council in cities having the commission form of government, and to add section sixty-five hundred seventy-eight-b two (6578-b2).

# Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. That section sixty-five hundred sixty-four (6564) of the code, 1935, be and the same is hereby amended by inserting at the end of said section after the word "created"\* the following words: "except as such powers and duties may be changed or modified by subsequent sections of this chapter."
- That section sixty-five hundred seventy-eight (6578) of the code, 1935, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following to be numbered sixty-five hundred seventy-eight-b two 3 (6578-h2)† Parks and Park Commissioners: The provisions of chapter 5 293, relating to parks and park commissioners, shall be applicable 6 to and be in force in cities and towns organized under the provisions of this chapter to the same extent and effect that such provisions are 8 applicable to and in force in cities and towns of the same class organized under the general laws of the state. The board of park commissioners shall have and may exercise all powers conferred upon 10 them by the provisions of said chapter. 11
  - SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the Fort Dodge Messenger and Chronicle, a newspaper published at Fort Dodge, Iowa, and the Dayton Review, a newspaper published at Dayton, Iowa, without expense to the state.
