# CHAPTER 239

#### MUNICIPAL COURT

S. F. 389

AN ACT to amend section ten thousand six hundred sixty-one (10661), code, 1935, relating to the transfer of records from superior, police, and mayor's courts to the municipal court.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section ten thousand six hundred sixty-one (10661),
- 2 Code, 1935, is amended by inserting after the word "towns" in line
- 3 four thereof the words "other than that".

#### CHAPTER 240

#### LIMITATIONS OF ACTIONS

S. F. 322

AN ACT to amend subsection four (4) of section eleven thousand seven (11007), code, 1935, relating to limitations of actions.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Subsection four (4) of section eleven thousand seven (11007), Code, 1935, is amended by striking the period at the end
- 3 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof a comma (,) and the following:
- 4 "provided that actions against a sheriff, deputy sheriff or other 5 peace officer founded on false arrest shall be brought within six months 6 after the exoneration or discharge of the person arrested."

## CHAPTER 241

### LEGAL NEWSPAPER

H. F. 613

AN ACT to repeal section eleven thousand ninety-nine-e one (11099-e1), code, 1935, and to enact a substitute therefor, relating to the definition of a legal newspaper.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section eleven thousand ninety-nine-e one (11099-e1), Code, 1935, is hereby repealed and the following is enacted in lieu thereof:
- 4 (1) "Newspaper" defined. For the purpose of establishing and 5 giving assured circulation to all notices and/or reports of proceedings 6 required by statute to be published within the state, where newspapers
- 7 are required to be used, newspapers of general circulation that have 8 been established, published regularly and mailed through the post
